Project Information

Pre-selection of Project Paintbrush

An assessment of the home/fence must be done prior to being selected for Project Paintbrush, with the consent of the homeowner. Experts in exterior home painting and a Volunteer Lethbridge representative will visit the site to assess the condition of the house/fence and estimate the supplies required to paint the house. The homeowner will be notified if they are selected for Project Paintbrush *after* the assessment.

Post Selection of Project Paintbrush

Prep Day: Exterior painting requires that the house/fence be sanded, washed, necessary repairs be made, and primed. Volunteers will perform these tasks in two or more days. This day will be decided upon based on volunteers and homeowners availability.

Paint Day: After the “prep day” another set of volunteers will return to paint the exterior of the house. Volunteers will perform these tasks in one or more days. This day will be decided upon based on volunteers and homeowners availability.

What to expect:

- A pre-selection assessment of home prior to being selected for Project Paintbrush;
- Two or more days;
- Approximately 8-25 volunteers each project day;
- At least 1 volunteer Team Leader will be present at project site (home) at all times. They will possess site safety knowledge, First Aid training, and will have a clear police record check;
- Media crews may be present (see media consent form);
- A project display will be at project site;
- We will provide volunteers with lunch, water and snacks at project site;
- Homeowners must provide a washroom/hand wash station for volunteers to use during project days;
- Volunteers will ensure clean up of all project materials;
- If you have family members and/or friends physically able to assist, we would warmly welcome them to join us with prep work and painting.
